RETURN COMPLETED FORM TO SCHOOL OR PROGRAM REPRESENTATIVE

Durham School Services Transportation in collaboration with the Hail Mary Project, and the Waterloo Community School District (WCSD) will be providing afterschool transportation from George Washington Carver Academy, and Central Middle School. Durham bus(es) will be dropping students off at the Cedar Valley Sportsplex, immediately after dropping off students going to the Boys & Girls Club. For students coming from Bunger, and Hoover Middle Schools, alternative rides MUST be coordinated by the parent/guardian to the Sportsplex. This is because the buses utilized by Hail Mary Project are the same buses that transport students directly to the Boys & Girls Club, and those buses only bring students from Carver & Central. Programming is expected to begin approximately 15 minutes after bus arrival, typically by 3:45pm and should end around 5:30pm, with a provided dinner to follow after the activities. The curriculum will happen during dinner as well.

Transportation will be provided on the **FRIDAYS** and **WEDNESDAY** (as space is available) and will include the following guidelines:

1. A copy of this permission slip must be on file with WCSD and Durham School Services before child can be allowed to ride the bus to the Sportsplex.
2. All students riding the bus to the Sportsplex MUST participate in the program activities as intended.
3. It will be your child's responsibility to be at the bus stop at the appropriate time of pickup. The bus will depart from the school at 2:43 PM. The bus will wait 7-8 minutes after school is let out and will not return to pick up the children who miss the bus.
4. Any student not observing Durham School Services or WCSD policy; or the Hail Mary Project rules may be suspended or dropped from the program.
5. **ANY BUS SUSPENSIONS will result in the parent be responsible for the child to be transported to the program for the duration of the suspension!**
6. All students will be required to stay seated while riding the bus or van.
7. All students must be respectful of other passengers, and staff on the bus, or suspension could result

***It's extremely important that communication is fluid between the parent/guardian and the organizers of the program because there may be capacity limits on the buses, which may cause us to have to coordinate alternate transportation OR have the parent designate someone to pick up their student.**

I have read and understand the guidelines and rules for participation in the Hail Mary Project after school Transportation program.
